Domains – Frontier Optional Feature

OVERVIEW

Frontier's Domains optional feature supports the restriction of user command privileges for specific objects defined in the Frontier system – an ideal solution for enterprise systems. The Domains feature offers:

Flexibility

Frontier's Domains feature allows for fine-tune control of user command privileges of specified Frontier objects. For example, without the Domains feature, if a user is granted permission to unlock doors, the user can unlock any door in the system. With the Domains feature, specific doors can be restricted from specific users – limiting the user's ability to control doors that are not included in the user's domain.

The Domains feature has two options; badge domains or device domains. The Badge domains option includes badges only, while the device domains option includes: access groups, alarms, calendars, devices, door groups, doors/elevators, interface devices, outputs, passback zones, reports, schedules, user groups and users.

Ease of Use

The Domains feature is configured using Frontier's intuitively designed Graphical User Interface (GUI) making initial setup and modifications effortless.
