Two Badge and Two Person – Frontier Optional Feature

TWO PERSON OVERVIEW

Two Person is an optional feature providing the ability to ensure a specified area always contains AT LEAST two badgeholders. Two Badge is an optional feature providing the ability to require two different valid badges to be presented at a reader before access will be granted to a portal. The Two Person feature offers:

Flexibility

Two Person gives the ability to configure passback zones requiring at least two badgeholders to be inside the passback zone. An example of the Two Person feature is a cash room in a bank where at least two employees must be in the cash room.

Assurance

The Two Badge feature will not allow one badgeholder access to the zone. If the zone is empty, two valid badge swipes of different cards are required to gain access (as part of a single transaction). When all badgeholders leave the zone, the two badgeholders are required to swipe different badges (as part of a single transaction).

TWO PERSON REQUIREMENTS

Frontier

- Version 5.7.1.5 or greater
- The doors in a Two Person zone cannot be assigned to more than one building controller.
- Two Person license

Hardware

- RCM1 with a revision of R4.2.9 or greater (RCM1s with an older revision need this option enabled in the firmware)
- RCM2
- MS Reader must have this option enabled in the firmware

Two Person and Two Badge – Frontier Optional Feature

TWO BADGE OVERVIEW

Two Badge is an optional feature providing the ability to require two different valid badges to be presented at a reader before access will be granted to a portal. An example for Two Badge is when a badgeholder must swipe a badge for his/her automobile at a gate and also swipe their personal badge to gain access. The Two Badge Feature provides:

Flexibility

Two Badge is configured per door allowing the capability to have an area designated a Two Badge portal. The option is configurable based on your needs. Two Badge can be configured to require:

- Two valid badges from the same company
- Matching companies between the two badges
- Two badges from two different badge classes.
- Two badges that are from the same specified badge classes

Dependability

The Two Badge option is dependable by not accepting entry when one badge is swiped. Based on configuration, the display window at the reader will read "Waiting..." until the second badge is swiped.

TWO BADGE REQUIREMENTS

Frontier

- Version 5.7.1.1.3 or greater
- Multiple Employment Record option must be disabled in Frontier.
- Two Badge license

Hardware

- RCM™ versions 4.2.9 or greater
- MS Readers™ or pre-4.0.0 RCM™ versions will have to be investigated on a case-by-case basis
